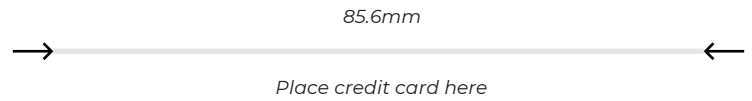


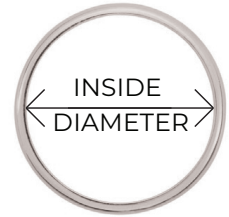
HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

Before printing, ensure this guide is set to print at 100% scale and that you are printing on standard US letter paper (215.9mm x 279.4mm). If you are unsure as to whether you have printed the correct size, or if you are measuring on a screen, place a credit card on the guide.



OPTION 1

The easiest way to work out your ring size is to use an existing ring. Use a ring you wear frequently for sizing. Simply match the inside of the ring to one of the circles below. You should only see the black circle inside of your ring and little to no white paper. The estimated size appears inside the circle. Use this method if you have a ring that perfectly fits the finger on which you would like to wear your new Karini's ring.



OPTION 2

After your cut out the ruler, cut the line to create an opening.

Wrap the ruler around your finger with the numbers visible like in the diagram.

The number that appears closest to the slit is your ring size. Try moving the ruler across your knuckle, we recommend selecting a size that goes on and off your finger easily. Please note, ring size may vary slightly depending on the ring style.



TIPS

- Measure your finger in the evening .
- Do not measure your finger in extreme heat or cold.
- Keep in mind that your fingers are not the same size on your other hand.
- Make sure the ring can move comfortably along the entire length of your finger in your chosen size.

- If using a measuring tape, or a ring sizer, make sure it fits comfortably enough not to slip off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle.
- If buying a thicker ring, we would recommend you go up a size.
- Sizing availability is specific to each product, though some larger rings can be sized down.
- Ring size may also vary slightly depending on style or width of the ring.
